



FIRST YEAR COURSE OF STUDY

2. BIBLE BOOK BY BOOK. During the first year this course covers in minute detail the first five books of the Bible. Every chapter and verse comes under the students observation.

3. LIFE OF PAUL. As the subject suggests, the life of Paul is traced carefully. His early history, conversion, missionary journeys, trials, and tribulations, and his victorious life come in for consideration and profit.

4. ACTS. In this course special stress is placed upon the acts of the Holy Spirit. Pentecostal truths are definitely set forth.

5. LIFE OF CHRIST. This course differs from Christology in that it deals more specifically with the works and ministry of Christ from Bethlehem to the Cross.

Historical Field.

1. MISSIONS. Special emphasis is placed upon our own Home Missions in North Dakota during the first year. The course is historical in that it deals more specifically with reviewing the progress of Home Missions in the past. A view of the present day field is presented together with qualifications and standards for workers.

2. CHURCH HISTORY. The aim of this course is to acquaint the student with the growth and progress of the Christian Church from the days of the apostles to the present.

3. AGES AND DISPENSATIONS. This course may be classified as historical in that it traces the movements of God upon the earth from Eternity to Eternity. The Bible contains some clear-cut and well-defined dispensations which are given careful consideration.

Practical Field.

1. SUNDAY SCHOOL METHODS. The aim here is to equip the student to go forth to conduct a successful Sunday School.

2. PERSONAL EVANGELISM. A great need is felt for Christians who are able and willing to go forth into the highways and by-ways to win the lost to Christ. This course is designed to develop and send forth just such workers.

3. CHILD STUDY. The various dispositions of the growing child are carefully considered in this course. Ways and means of dealing with the various age groups are emphasized.
