



FIRST YEAR COURSE OF STUDY

4. **BIBLE READING AND PULPIT MANNERISMS.** The thought in this course is to train the student for clear, forceful, effective reading of God's Word from the Pulpit. Offensive pulpit mannerisms are called to the students attention with the desire to assist him in pleasing and natural poise while behind the sacred desk.

5. **CHURCH ORGANIZATION AND ADMINISTRATION.** In this course the student is acquainted with inner workings of a normal church life. Students are trained to become good Deacons, and Board Members.

Field Of Music.

1. **MUSIC.** This course is prepared to acquaint the student with the rudiments of music.

2. **RADIO CHOIR.** The field covered here includes practice in singing special songs, as well as practice in group singing. Actual experience is obtained by the weekly broadcast from the local Broadcasting Station.

The Field Of Languages.

1. **ENGLISH.** This course prepares the student to go forth and present the Gospel in a proper and efficient way. Since speech is our most important vehicle of expression, it is well to learn to speak properly.

SECOND YEAR COURSE OF STUDY

The Theological Field.

1. **DOCTRINE OF GOD.** This is one of the most interesting of Theological subjects. It goes thoroughly into the subject and proves the existance of the one true and only God in contrast to the many so-called gods of the heathen. Although the truth of the one t true God is stressed, His eternal existance in the three persons of Father, Son and Holy Spirit is also emphasized.

2. **CHRISTOLOGY II.** The design of this course is to take the student deeper into the study of our exhaustless, eternal and ever blessed Lord and Saviour, Jesus Christ.

3. **SOTERIOLOGY (DOCTRINES OF SALVATION).** During year II this course centers entirely in the Book of Romans, which perhaps, better than any other book in the Bible, sets forth the glorious truth of man's redemption.
