



SECOND YEAR COURSE OF STUDY

5. **HOMILETICS.** The science of preparing sermons. The student is taught the various ways of presenting the Word of God in an effectual way.

6. **PUBLIC READING AND VOICE CULTURE.** This course trains the student to cultivate a pleasing and well modulated voice in public reading of the Bible as well as in preaching.

The Field of Music.

1. **MUSIC.** A continuation of study in the rudiments and technique of music.

2. **Radio CHOIR.** Training in special singing as well as group singing. Also actual participation in the radio program.

3. **ORCHESTRA.** Prospective students are urged to bring their instruments.

The field of Languages.

1. **ENGLISH.** The emphasis the second year will be placed upon composition and theme writing.

2. **GREEK.** A study of New Testament Greek designed to assist the student in a better understanding of God's Word.

In the school year of 1949-1950, we shall endeavor to provide as much as possible in the way of Recreation. This will probably include such games as table tennis, dart games, and games of a like nature. Perhaps we can have better skating facilities, croquet, horseshoe, etc.

The School also has a Social Night every other week, at which times the students enjoy many of the great blessings of God in Christian Fellowship and play. Such occasions are taken advantage of as Christmas, Thanksgiving, Halloween, etc., for parties, and at other times all are invited out to some home for a sleigh-ride party, or an evening of fellowship and fun.
