



Every Thursday afternoon the H. C. B. I. students are divided into six practical works groups. They hold services in the Americana Nursing Center, the City Rest Home, and the City and County Jails. One group distributes tracts and other Christian literature to hotels, motels, depots, and laundromats. As these groups minister the sixth group remains at school to pray for God's blessing on the other groups. These activities provide an opportunity to put to practice lessons learned in the classroom as well as spreading the gospel throughout the city of Aberdeen.

Another field of service, where students are engaged weekly, is among the Indians on the reservation south of Mobridge. This missionary effort, carried on in the homes of these early Americans, presents a challenge to the students as they present the gospel to them.
