the lives of many students.

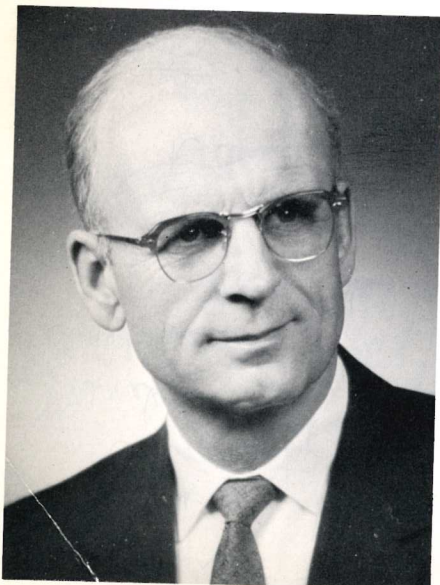
SCHOOL SCRIPTURE: "...be thou in the fear of the Lord all the day long."
