




#### DOCTRINAL STATEMENT



#### MRS. CAROLINE KESLER, MATRON





#### HISTORY

The Lakewood Park Bible School will be one year old on August 2, 1949, as it was on this date that the first \$500.00 was paid down on the larger of the two buildings that now comprise the Bible School.

Rev. L. E. Englar had the vision for this School for some time, and felt it to be a need in the North Dakota District. After spending a little time in the spring of 1948, helping in the construction of the beautiful buildings which comprise the Camp Ground proper, he decided to bring the project before the District Presbyters at the Camp Meeting, held the last of June, and the first of July, 1948.

Some remodeling and repair was necessary, and more will become necessary as time goes on.




DIGGING THE BASEMENT

The Project was brought before the District Council, and agreed almost unanimously that the School should be started as soon as feasible. It was then taken before the District Presbyters, and after considering every possible phase of such an important undertaking, it was decided to go ahead with the construction and try to have the buildings ready by October 1.

At this time Rev. W. H. Kesler and Rev. G. L. Riffe became very interested in this project, and also gave much valued thought and help in getting started.

JUST BEFORE SCHOOL STARTED

Dr. J. E. Purdie, Principal of Western Bible College at Vinnipeg. Manitoba, consented co come down to this Camp Meeting, and speak in the Council Meeting on behalf of a School of this nature. He endorsed it heartily, and offered two full years of his Course of Study, which included books, notes, etc., for our School to use. This is considered the finest set of notes that could be obtained anywhere. For this great favor we agreed to encourage our students to attend Western Bible College for their third year.


We very much appreciate the fine help and encouragement that Dr. Purdie has been to the School.

Construction was started immediately. Two basements were dug, and cement blocks were used in building these basements. A large basement, 68X26 feet, was dug for the building from Egeland, and one, 28X28 feet, was dug for the building from Egeland, or rather, Leeds.

At present, the large building is only 54X26, but we plan to build an addition to this soon, for more dormitory space.




ONE OF THE LARGE CISTERNS

The building moved in from Leeds is used to house the boys dormitory, one apartment, a chapel in the basement, also used for classroom.

Two large cisterns, one twelve feet deep and fifteen feet in diameter, and one twelve feet deep and ten feet in diameter, were also constructed, as the water supply presented a major problem, and this temporarily met the need.

Rev. W. H. Kesler and Rev L. E. Englar are the resident teachers in charge of the School. Rev. G. L. Riffe, the Sec.-Treas. of the N. Dak. District, and Miss Mildred Duncklee, of Bowesmont, N. Dak. are also on the teaching staff. Miss Duncklee is a graduate of Western Bible College.

The faculty extends a hearty thank you to all who have helped us through this first year, and for all your prayers.

School opening day had to postponed for one week, due to the shortness of time allotted to the building operations.

Also, the boy's dormitory had not arrived. But it was generally agreed that the Lord had surely performed a miracle, as it were, in making it possible for the Lakewood Park Bible School to open on Oct. 18,1948.

The Board of Directors for the Bible School consists of the following men: Rev. G. L. Riffe, President; Rev. W. H. Kesler, Principal; Rev. L. E. Englar, Sec.-Treas. & Business Manager; Rev. H. G. Hohnson and Rev. C. L. Strom.







The Lord saw fit to send us eighteen students for the first year, and every one is agreed that it has been a very profitable year.


Five of these students have received the Baptism of the Holy Spirit, and some have made plans to answer the call of God to their respective fields of service after graduating.


Beginning with the fall term of 1949, an entrance examination will be given to each student. This examination will cover simple, elementary truths regarding Bible subjects as well as English Those who pass this examination will be able to enroll in the regular Bible School Course, as Year I students. Those who do not pass will be enrolled in a special one year preparatory course. This Preparatory Course is not only designed so that students who take this one year only, will receive a well balanced Course of Study. but also that students who may be able to attend either the first or second semester will receive a fine, well balanced short term Course A description of this Preparatory Course, as well as the subjects given in the first Two Years of the regular Bible School Course follows: PREPARATORY COURSE 1. BIBLE BOOK BY BOOK. The text book used will be Myer Pearlman's book, entitled "Through the Bible Book by Book". The student will cover the entire Bible during this one year. 2. SEEING THE STORY OF THE BIBLE. In this course the student will be given a "Bird's eye view" of the Bible. Again, Myer Pearlman's book will be used as a text. 3. PRAYER. This course is designed to acquaint the student with the teaching of the Bible on this important subject. Much time will be given to actual prayer, as well. 4. BIBLE GEOGRAPHY. In this course the student will become familiar with the geography of Bible lands. There will also be simple lessons in map work. 5. SUCCESSFUL SUNDAY SCHOOL. The purpose of this course will be to teach the fundamental principles of Sunday School work. The pupil will discover just what it takes to make a successful Sunday School. 6. SCRIPTURE MEMORIZING. The aim here will be to teach the student the value of scripture memorizing and to lead him into the actual memorizing of many precious portions of God's Word. 7. PERSONAL EVANGELISM. This course is designed to assist the student in the actual work of soul winning. It is our aim to develope each student into an efficient, successful fisher of men. 8. PENTECOSTAL TRUTHS. We feel there is a great lack of knowledge regarding the precious doctrines of our great Pentecostal movement. This course is given to impart a Biblical knowledge of Pentecostal beliefs which we hold dear.


