BROTHER WILLIAMS

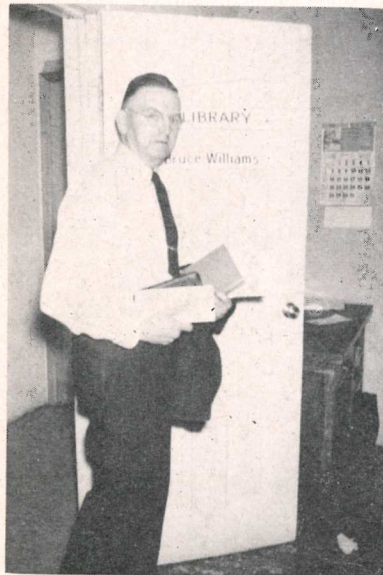
