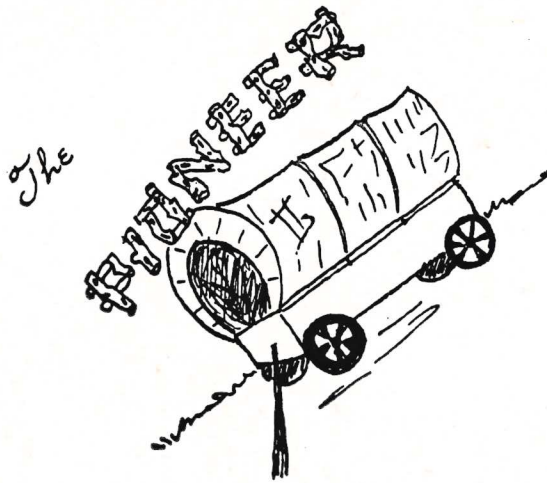

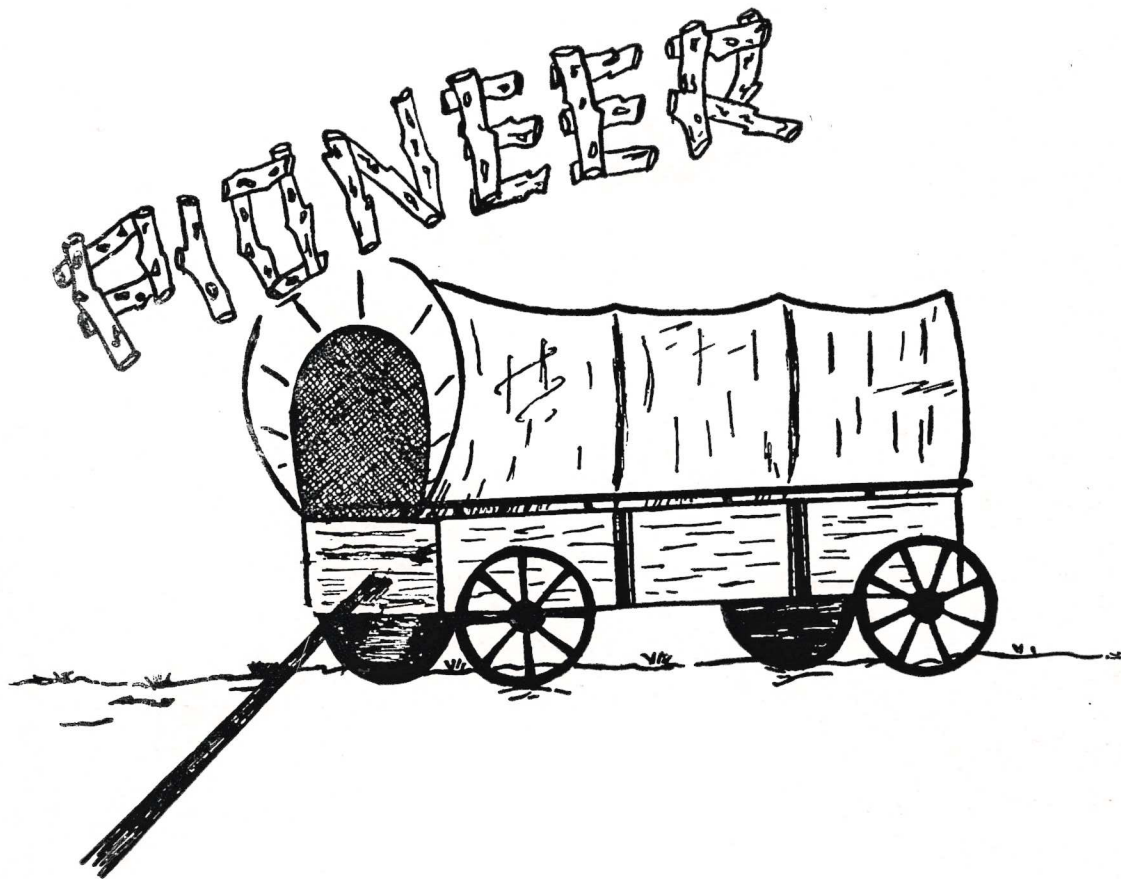
These memories draw us closer in the bonds of Christian love and fellowship.
