Without any reservation we can say that the purpose of a Bible School is salvation. Bible School is not an end in itself but a means to an end. If L.P.B.S. does not bring about the result of more souls being saved than would otherwise have been saved its existence is not justified. Most of our young people who attend Bible School would live an average and somewhat useful Christian life without such training. However, it is to be greatly hoped and highly anticipated that the efficiency of each one will be much increased by the three years of intensive and prayerful preparation of heart and head which he receives at Lakewood Park Bible School. We are fully assured that many souls are now saved who would never have been saved had it not been for our own District Bible School. May this be increasingly true in the years to come should the Lord tarry.

Now when we state that the purpose of a Bible School is salvation we also have another phase of this matter in mind. Justification from the penalty of sin is only one aspect of salvation. Both faculty and students of any Bible School are standing in present need of salvation. We need to be saved from the self life. We have not yet attained. We must still press toward the mark.
