Outstation work at Bowdle

Every Thursday afternoon the students of Hub City Bible Institute are divided into groups to go out on practical works. We go to present the gospel to the people in the rest homes and jails of Aberdeen, Redfield, and Ellendale. One group distributes tracts and Christian literature in the hotels, laundromats, and depots. Another group stays at the school and prays for those who have gone to present the gospel. Practical works has helped many of the students realize the responsibilities of their future ministry and the need of the gospel in the world today.

Another avenue of ministry is to the American Indians on the reservation south of Mobeidge. A group goes there every other week-end to present the gospel message to them.

An outstation work is also being carried on at Bowdle. Every Sunday a different group of students go to Bowdle to hold services at the church. This work has been a challenge to many of the students, who have ministered there.




